- Vapes, marijuana, tobacco.
- Weapons, firearms or any look-alike weapons
- Be aware that there is no bike storage allowed inside of the dorms. If you have an expensive bike that you do not want to store outdoors in a bike rack, it would be better for you to leave it at home.
- Pets are not allowed in residence rooms.
- Car tires can not be stored in dorm residence. (fire hazard)
- Be aware that this will be your home, but that this new home has limited space available. Please avoid over-packing!
